**Day 1:** Tbilisi's rawness is best discovered in some of its outskirts. The magnitude of Soviet blocs and the unique architecture that goes along with it. We will bring you to these Soviet jewels while you cruise through the undiscovered districts with your Soviet means of transportation. We visit the Chronicles of Georgia, the most special Soviet blocs, deserted USSR-era buildings and the abandoned Rustavi steel factory. At the end of the day we drive on to Signaghi. Here we spent the night in a small family guesthouse. Home grown & cooked food and homemade wines await us.

**Day 2:** From Signaghi we head towards Telavi. We stop at our first winery; one of the biggest and oldest of Georgia. A perfect place to get some basic knowledge on Georgian winemaking. We drive on towards Telavi, where we visit a totally different winery, a small wine maker that operates from the home. The passion and small scale, yet very personal, will make it an experience to remember. Next up is a biodynamic winery. This winery is located at the foot of Alazani valley, overlooking wine fields and the Caucasus Mountains, truly a magical place. The wine maker believes in an all-natural process of winemaking. Examples: Sheep come in the winter to graze among the vines, only horses and hands are used to make this wine in a way that it has been done in Georgia for 8000 years. This is the real thing.
