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8-day Road Trip

Everything described in this package is included within the total price of the package. Breakfast, lunch and dinner and with every meal there are no limits whatsoever when it comes to food and drinks. In addition, both lunch and dinner are warm and very comprehensive meals. You can leave your wallet at home. From experience we know this is the most practical and comfortable way. The only thing you have to do as our guest enjoy the vintage feel of our cars the nature, culture, the unique Georgian hospitality and the amazing cuisine and drinks to go along with that.

On the road we will visit a lot of sights; century old churches and other buildings but also the most amazing viewing points. There are a lot to mention that is why you will not find all of them back in the day-to-day planning below. Nevertheless, visiting these sights is a must to seep in the unique culture of the country.



*The only extra costs you will have are those you opt for. Since every group has different interests, these are calculated afterwards. They are added to the total package price. Below the package is described what activities can be done at what point.

Day 1: We take on Tbilisi. We visit its highlights but also those places more unknown but definitely not less interesting. We discover the small streets of the old town with all the courtyards, balconies and other characteristics that make this city the unique place it is. At night we have our first encounter with



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Georgian food. Just like the city is inspired by influences from all neighboring countries, so is its cuisine; throughout history Georgia was a hotspot for spice trade from East to West. At night we go out, we drink.

Day 2: We take our Zjiguli's (=Lada's) and drive out West. We head for the Borjomi Kharagauli National Park, one of the biggest natural reserves in Europe. Borjomi is famous for its lush and green sights. Also, it's famous for its Spa's and "healing" waters. The reputation of the Borjomi water went as far as that during the USSR the Soviet Elite came to Borjomi to rest and heal.



Day 3: The Lower Svanetian mountains await us; "Racha" is up next. Even for Georgian standards Racha is a quit undiscovered territory for visitors. The local population is known for its relaxed attitude and the calm nature. The amazingly situated roads will give you exactly this chill out vibe. It also makes that you will experience the untouched and authentic rural Georgia. Again we stay at the most authentic guesthouses with the best home cooked Georgian meals.

Day 4: We spent another day in the village of Oni. We have the option to raft on the Racha Rivers or simply just to enjoy Racha's calmness.

Day 5: Before we drive towards the high peaks of the Caucasus mountain range we make a pit stop in Tbilisi. The apparent differences between the rural Georgia and Tbilisi are huge. So before we hit up the next natural delights we enjoy the city.



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Day 6: We take on the famous Georgian Military Highway. This road leads to the 5000M high Mt. Kazbeg. Views on this ride are just stunning. Again, for what is so unique about Georgia, in one day we drive from the capital city towards Europe's highest mountain range. The diversity along the way is something special. In particular since it offers you to see such a range of natural beauty in a relatively short time. Please find more information below on paragliding through the Caucasus mountain range.

Day 7: From the high mountains we drive to the Georgia's main wine region. The area is filled with endless steppe plains and beautiful wine yards. The roads we take subtly carve through the area. We visit a couple of towns. And naturally we try to get some understanding of the unique and extensive Georgian wine culture.



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Day 8: From Kakheti we head for Tbilisi again. Beautiful sights in ever changing natural sceneries. On the way back we find ourselves in a desert like area, out here we have to change to get a game of paintball going.
